

Dear ERASMUS+/International Exchange Student,

Thank you for choosing to study at Cardenal Cisneros University College (CUCC).

We would like to provide you with some important information, including the academic calendar, eligible courses, and holidays.

1 ACADEMIC CALENDAR

Notice that, in Spain, one academic year is divided into two equal semesters of 15 weeks of class each. After each semester, there is an examination period. **Therefore, the General Calendar is as follows:**

- **1st semester (Autumn):** Classes start in early September and finish just before Christmas.
Ordinary examination period last two weeks in mid-January.
- **2nd semester (Spring):** Classes start in late January and finish in mid-May.
Ordinary examination period last two weeks in late May to June.

However, there are some exceptions in certain years in the Degrees of Infant, Primary, and Social Education. This is so due to **external training internships** being done at **schools or social institutions**.

For the **4th Year** and during the Spring semester, there are no other subjects but Practicum (external training practice for all Degrees) and the making and defence of the Final Degree Project.

Finally, there is an **extraordinary period of examinations** only intended for those students who failed in the ordinary ones, either in the Autumn or Spring semesters. It takes place in June until early July.

3 COURSES SELECTION AND LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

Subjects can only be selected from the list of courses taught at CUCC and within the **bachelor's degrees** your university has signed an **Erasmus+ Inter-Institutional Agreement** with us. Study guides will be **updated in July**. Please check our website <https://inter.cardenalcisneros.es/incoming> for possible changes and additional information in English.

Notice that **Spanish** is the **main language of instruction** at **CCUC**. It is necessary to **certify a minimum B2 European CFRL level** or equivalent to **follow programmes in Spanish**.

- In the Degree in **SOCIAL EDUCATION**, subjects are taught **only in Spanish**.
- In the Degree in **PSYCHOLOGY**, several subjects are taught **partially in English**. This means that practical classes and seminars are given in English (60% of tuition) but theoretical classes in Spanish. However, class notes, exams, and tutorials are available in English.
- In the **Bilingual Curriculum** of the Degrees in **INFANT EDUCATION** and **PRIMARY EDUCATION**, tuition is entirely provided in English (minimum **B1 CFRL** level required).
- In the **English Specialization** of the previous Degrees, a minimum **B2 European CFRL level** is **required** to follow courses.
