



Dear ERASMUS+/International Exchange Student,

Thank you for choosing to study at Cardenal Cisneros University College (CUCC). We would like to provide you with some important information, including the academic calendar, eligible courses, and holidays.

1 ACADEMIC CALENDAR

Notice that, in Spain, one academic year is divided into two equal semesters of 15 weeks of class each. After each semester, there is an examination period. **Therefore, the General Calendar is as follows:**

• 1st semester (Autumn): Classes start in early September and finish in late December.

Ordinary examination period last two weeks in January.

• 2nd semester (Spring): Classes start in late January and finish in early May.

Ordinary examination period last two weeks in mid-May to June.

However, there are some exceptions in certain years in the Degrees of Infant, Primary, and Social Education. This is so due to **external training internships** being done at **schools or social institutions**.

For the **4**th **Year** and during the Spring semester, there are not other subjects but Practicum (external training practice for all Degrees) and the End of Degree Project and its Oral Defence.

Finally, there is an **extraordinary period of examinations** only intended for those students who failed in the ordinary ones, either in the Autumn or Spring semesters. It takes place in June until early July.

3 COURSES SELECTION AND LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

Subjects can only be selected from the list of courses taught at CUCC and within the degrees your university has signed an **Erasmus+Inter-Institutional Agreement** with us.

Notice that **Spanish** is the **main language of instruction** at **CCUC**. It is necessary to **certify a minimum B2 European CFRL level** or equivalent **to follow programmes in Spanish**.

- In the Degrees in **Social Education** and **Psychology**, subjects are only taught in **Spanish**.
- There is an offer of **English-Friendly (EF) subjects in Psychology**. This means that tuition is in Spanish, although class notes, practices, exams, and tutorials are available in English.
- Courses taught in English (minimum B1 CFRL level required) belong to the Degrees in Infant Education (Bilingual Curriculum) and Primary Education (Bilingual Curriculum).
- A minimum **B2 European CFRL level is required** to follow courses in the **English Specialization** in the Degrees in **Infant** and **Primary Education**.
